



Post-Screening Discussion Manual

Purpose

The documentary tells the story of the mountain, its community, and sustainability challenges. This discussion guide helps organizers engage the audience, encourage reflection, and inspire action. Every voice counts, and every idea can make a difference.

Agenda

1. Welcome and Introduction (1–2 minutes)

- Thank the audience for attending.
- Briefly introduce the purpose of the documentary and the discussion session.

2. Set the Ground Rules (1–2 minutes)

- Encourage respectful listening and open sharing.
- One person speaks at a time.
- Emphasize that all opinions are valued.

3. Guided Discussion Questions (15–20 minutes)

- Sample questions
 - What part of the documentary impacted you the most?
 - What challenges do you think the mountain and its community face?
 - How can individuals or organizations contribute to preserving the mountain's environment?
 - How do you see your role in supporting sustainability and local initiatives?
 - What action can you take after the screening?

5. Closing (1 minutes)

- Thank everyone for their participation.



- Encourage connecting with relevant initiatives, organizations, or partners
- Share resources, links, or contacts for further engagement.

Tips for Organizers

- Encourage participation but avoid pressuring anyone to speak.
- Keep the discussion solution-focused and positive.
- Record the discussion if possible, or take notes to summarize afterward
- Remind participants that small actions can create meaningful impact.
